In connection with horse transports in lorries on Austrian roads during weekends we have seen a growing number of fines issued to participants in horse shows coming from your countries

In order to avoid these costly fines (amounting in €200) it is necessary to apply for an exemption beforehand.

This exemption can only be granted by the federal government concerned (that is the authority of the federal state where you first cross border).
